#### **Old Testament**



The Old Testament is the front section of your Bible. It has 39 smaller books.

#### **New Testament**



The New Testament follows the Old Testament. It has 27 smaller books.



## **DID YOU KNOW?**



The Bible was written by over 40 different authors.

It was written over a period of some 1,500 years.

Psalms is the longest book.

When you see a Bible reference like this, it shows us the book, chapter, and verse in the Bible. This makes it easy to find the exact part we want to read.

Take 30 seconds and thank God for the Bible.




Take 45 seconds ask God to help you not be distracted as you read.


